PERFORMANCE BEGINS OUTSIDE

The first work on the program, *Harboring*, takes place **outside** on the exterior of Meany Hall adjacent to the main entrance. The audience will stand for the 15-minute performance before moving inside for the remainder of the performance where patrons will be seated in their purchased seat location.

The auditorium and main lobby will be open for anyone who does not wish to stand for the outside performance.

RAIN OR SHINE, THE SHOW GOES ON

The outside performance will take place, rain or shine. Bring your rain gear if it looks like showers!

STROBE LIGHTS

Strobe lights will be used during the second half of *Harboring* that takes place inside Meany Hall.

WILL CALL AND BOX OFFICE

The Will Call booth and Box Office open at 7:00 p.m. Please pick up or purchase your tickets prior to the start of the outside performance at 8 p.m.

PRE-SHOW FILM SCREENING OF *SHIFT*

Come early to watch a short film of BANDALOO performing at Yosemite. The film begins at 7:10 p.m. in the main auditorium. The screening is free to ticketholders.

CONCESSIONS AND BAR

Food and beverages will be available prior to the performance in the main and lower lobbies. Concessions and bar will close at 7:50 p.m. for the duration of the first work on the program but will reopen for intermission. Alcohol is not permitted outside.
